BONANZA RANCH

Began operations in 2007 with 10 horses, within the complex of El Dorado Royale, El Dorado Casitas Royale and Generations Riviera Maya. Thanks to the vast expansion of the property, its location in the heart of Riviera Maya and the richness of flora and fauna of the region, an idea was born - to create an activity for guests and external visitors where they could firsthand experience contact with nature. Such activities include horseback riding through the jungle, swimming in a cenote, bird-watching, and interacting with reptiles, butterflies & other animals typical of our Mayan jungle.

Throughout these years, the main objective of Bonanza Ranch has been to preserve the values that we live by- our immense love for Mexico & pride for our land, the care and responsibility we have for our children, generating sources for working decently, caring for our environment and especially, our commitment to create experiences for our guests that will turn into joyful memories.

TODAY BONANZA RANCH IS COMPRISED OF:

- Our 12 ambassadors (guides, cowboys, horse trainers veterinary and lifeguards).
- 30 horses and 10 donkeys (the vast majority rescued and rehabilitated).
- Mini rook with a miniature horse, miniature goats, peacocks and pigs.
- Restrooms, lockers and towels.
- Safety equipment for riding (helmets) and swimming (life jackets).
- 3 sets of stables, built with regional elements (palapa).
- 3 km long hiking paths through the jungle.
- 1 natural cenote where you can swim.
- 2 caves, where one is where an underground river emerges.
- Film and photo shoot locations.
- Horse and donkey rentals for weddings including Indian weddings.



TRUE MÉXICO

Our team building program is tailored for groups who enjoy natural beauty in a remarkable location such as Bonanza Rancho. Attendees can participate in team building activities, interact with colleagues, and experience healthy competition in a natural & beautiful environment.



CONCEPT

Group will be divided in teams. All teams must complete a series of challenges, both physical and mental skill, that takes advantage of the unique attractions of Bonanza Ranch.

Teams will be evaluated during the activity.
Teams with the best performances will win.

SUGGESTED OPERATION :

Meet at Bonanza Ranch stable.

Sound system, speakers, music and microphone will be set up.

Event staff will organize teams of 8-12 people, followed by icebreakers and warmups. Staff may wear traditional accessories such as mustaches, pistols, etc. It is suggested that participants wear classic Mexican bandanas as identifiers. Each team must assign a leader or captain who must wear a Mexican charro hat during the activity as well as come up with a Mexican name for the team and create a unique war chant involving. The most creative teams will receive extra points.

Activities will have a total 6-10 challenges to complete. Teams will go through all challenges in different order. For each challenge series, the Staff Manager will grant scores. The estimated time of each challenge is 8 - 10 minutes.

Once challenges are concluded, the group returns to the meeting point for staff to tally scores and recognize the 3 winning teams at the awards ceremony.



MEXICAN OBSTACLES

This task is a relay race! At the start of each obstacle (hula hoops, fences, crawling and crossing a spider web), each participant must pick and wear a typical Mexican item such as an Adelita skirt, poncho, or hat. Once the participant completes the track fully dressed Mexican-style, he/she will scream Mariachi and high-five the next participant in line so they can go.



MEXICAN HAT

In this challenge, each team member wears a pair of fins and a Mexican charro hat filled with balls. The task is to complete a track back and forth with as many balls as possible in the hat. The team with most balls in their hat at the end will get more

TUG OF WAR

Two teams will face off trying to win 2 battles out of 3. To spice things up, the losing team will have to take a tequila shot!



HUMAN TACO

Team members will be rolled around in the form of a human taco to the opposite end of the field where other teammate waits his/her turn. Teams with best times get more points!

SADDLE UP A HORSE

After receiving a brief "How to" explanation by a professional horse trainer, teams will have to rope and saddle a horse. The task is to complete the procedure before the allotted period of time expires.



THE KEY WORD

Each individual from your team will swim from one end to the other of the sinkhole to find a letter. Once everyone brings their letter to the starting line, arrange the letters to form a key word!

ANIMALS ARE THIRSTY

Each team will have to manipulate a device made with ropes and buckets. The objective is to carry water using the buckets without spilling it and without separating the buckets from the rope. Each participant will be standing 1.5 meters away from the other, and using the rope will pass the buckets from one participant to the other. When time is up, teams with the most water in their buckets win the challenge.

MAYAN SKILLS

This challenge consists of two stages that should be completed before the period of time concludes. The first is to complete a memory board composed of Mayan numbers and the second is to complete a board with common Mayan words and match them with their correct English meaning.



MEXICAN CHILDHOOD

Travel into the childhood of many Mexicans and put your skills to practice using two classic toys- a trompo and balero. Each team member will play with both toys and the team with most successful attempts earns a higher score. The challenge is that individually, each participant properly operates both toys, as more successful attempts means higher scores.

DONKEY LASSOING

This is a great challenge where teams receive a brief explanation and demonstration on how rope is used in this art. They will then test their ability trying to lassoing a donkey. Teams with best performances will score most points.
